### **RE: CLEMENTI DISTRICT SCOUTS FOUNDER'S DAY CHALLENGE 2015**

We are pleased to invite you to the abovementioned district event, an amazing race, organized by SP Rover Crew for both Cub Scouts and Scouts within the Clementi district. This event will be held in the premises of Singapore Polytechnic.

Date: **5 September** 2015 (Saturday)

Venue: Singapore Polytechnic (To report at **MLT 12**)

Time: 8.30 a.m. - 1.30 p.m.

### **Event Brief:**

There will be a total of 8 stations around SP premises. Participants will be given a map and they will need to decode the clues given to them to find out the location of the stations. These games will test their basic Scouting knowledge in-conjunction with the objectives of the activity itself and also teamwork.

Out of the 8 stations, 5 stations are designed for **both** Cubs Scouts and Scouts while the other 3 stations are designed for **only Scouts**. This means that the Cub Scouts are participating in only 5 stations and the Scouts are participating in **all** the 8 stations.

Each school is able to send up to 3 teams of 8 for Scouts and 3 teams of 11 inclusive of a teacher for Cub Scouts to participate in the amazing race. You are strongly encouraged to have a mixture of participants of different age for each team.

## Each participant will have to pay \$5.

We will also need volunteers for our event. Ventures and Rovers are strongly encouraged to volunteer. We are hoping to get a mixture of 25 helpers from ACS(I) and SJI.

Point system will be used to determine the winning teams. After completing the whole amazing race, the first five teams from each category (Cub Scouts, Scouts) with the highest points will be the winning teams. Teams will be awarded points at each station based on their performance, as there will be a point system for each game.

### Note:

- 1) Scout units are advised to issue their own consent/ indemnity forms. If not, forms can be downloaded from the Singapore Scout Association website.
- 2) Scout units are advised to arrange their own transportation.
- 3) Each school should be accompanied by a teacher-in-charge.
- 4) Scouts should wear their scarfs when reporting/ registering.
- 5) Participants are encouraged to bring a change of clothes.
- 6) All participants must be in proper attire. (Sports shoes, school/ scouts t-shirt and shorts)
- 7) Scouts are encouraged to travel light.
- 8) Ensure that Scouts are fit for activities and have breakfast before the event.
- 9) If any participant is not present on the event date, the team can participate only if they have at least 6 members.
- 10) Teams will be entertained on a first-come-first served basis at the checkpoint stations.
- 11) Points given by the station IC are final.
- 12) Schools are to indicate if they are coming by public transport or chartered bus. All <u>buses are to enter from Gate 3</u>. The meeting point is **MLT 12**. Attached is a map of SP.
